Application for consideration: Crown Tournament by Right of Treasury

Thank you for your interest in competing in the Crown Tournament. Unlike many other Crown Tournaments, you do not have to be a member of a special group, nor do you have to be proficient in a weapon style. For this competition, all you need is your desire to build a treasury, and enlist your friends and family to help you achieve the goal that you set. This packet contains an application and the rules that will govern this competition.

It should be noted that completion of this application and building a treasury does not automatically guarantee the applicant a place in the Royal Court, but it can qualify the applicant to win special prizes.

Rules and Eligibility

Membership

As this event is not sponsored by any outside organization, the event is open to all men and women who are above the age of 21 and have a love of the Medieval/Renaissance period. No membership dues, or registration to any organization is required.

Period

The period of the Yule Ball (for the Coronation Party) is Late Tudor/Elizabethan. If you are selected as one of the candidates for Coronation, you will be asked to have an appropriate outfit from this period (or reasonable facsimile thereof).

Election by Treasury

All candidates will be engaged in a war of the Treasury. This means that each candidate will compete by asking friends and family to help them build their treasury. OakStar Ministries will provide a site where friends and family can visit in order to make these contributions. The treasury competition will start September 1, 2011 and will end on November 30, 2011. The treasuries will be tallied and the top three males and females will be notified that they will be eligible for the title of Yule King and Yule Queen. All results will be posted on the OakStar Website no later than December 7, 2011.

Treasury

All candidates who participate will be eligible to receive the following awards:

- any candidate whose treasury contains \$500-\$999 will receive one (1) ticket to the Yule Ball (\$75 value)
- any candidate whose treasury contains \$1000-\$1499 will receive two (2) tickets to the Yule Ball (\$150 value)
- any candidate whose treasury contains \$1500-\$1999 will receive three (3) tickets to the Yule Ball (\$225 value)
- any candidate whose treasury contains \$2000-\$2499 will receive four (4) tickets to the Yule Ball (\$300 value)
- any candidate whose treasury contains \$2500 or more will receive five (5) tickets to the Yule Ball (\$375 value) or two (2) tickets to the VIP seating (\$250 value, one set available)

Election

The day of the Coronation, voting will commence at 12:00 noon on December 11, 2011. Each crown prince and princess will have a treasure chest located at the event. The amount raised prior to the election will be added to the amount of cash donations added to each prince's/princess' treasure chest. The crown prince and princess (regardless of relation to one another) will be crowned Yule King and Yule Queen for the duration of the ball and become an honorary director for the Yule Ball 2012.

Coronation

The Coronation will be held prior to the banquet feast, and will be presided over by the Archbishop of the Realm. The acceding prince and princess will be provided with a crown/coronet to be worn during the ball and a robe for coronation. These items will remain the property of OakStar Ministries and will be returned upon the completion of the event.

Removal from authority

A crowned King or Queen shall only be removed from office if it is determined that he/she acceded the throne under fraudulent means, or if an act has been perpetrated that would harm the reputation of the "ruling" monarch or OakStar Ministries. In such case, it will be made known that this monarch is abdicating their throne and the crown prince/princess whose treasury contained the second highest funds will be named in their place.

Questions of Authority

All authority to make decisions regarding the business of OakStar Ministries rests solely in its Board of Directors. The authority vested in the King and Queen is temporal and ceremonial in nature.
